Conduit Bid Specifications for Charlemont Broadband

Scope of Work:

The project involves excavation for and installation of underground conduit (microduct) along Heath Stage Terrace and Hawk Hill Road in Charlemont in preparation for future fiber optic cable installation. The Town of Charlemont will supply the conduit, junction boxes, and pedestals and the Contractor will supply additional materials as listed below. The fiber optic cable will be installed by others at a later date. The area will be restored by the Contractor as part of the contract. All work will occur within the Town roadway layout and easements are not anticipated.

Heath Stage Terrace Location

The work on Heath Stage Terrace involves installation and final site restoration of approximately 1,300' of 8-cell microduct beginning with a riser installation at pole #P35/T280 near Route 2 and extending to a junction box located on the property line between house #56 and house 64 as shown on the plans. The Contractor will also install (8) 17"x30" fiberglass flush mounted junction boxes for the main fiber run. In addition, the Contractor will install four road crossings using 4-cell microduct with each terminating at a 14"x16" junction box. The Contractor will also install (3) pedestals each with (2) schedule 40 PVC conduits with bends as shown on the plans.

Hawk Hill Road Location

The work on Hawk Hill Road involves installation and final site restoration of approximately 2,700' of 8-cell microduct beginning with a riser installation at pole #P12/T12 on East Oxbow Road and extending past Deer Run Lane to a riser pole installation at pole #P6/T6 on Hawk Hill Road as shown on plans. The work also includes installing approximately 300' of 8-cell microduct on Deer Run Lane which will terminate at a riser installation at pole #P25K/P1. The Contractor will install (8) 17"x30" fiberglass flush mounted junction boxes for the main fiber run and (1) 14"x16" junction box at a road crossing as shown on the plans. The Contractor will install (2) road crossings, one using 4-cell microduct and the other using 8 cell microduct. The Contractor will install (2) pedestals each with (2) schedule 40 PVC conduits with bends as shown on the plans.

Trenches

All trenches shall be 30" deep as shown on the fiber duct typical cross section. The conduit shall be 24" deep bedded on 6" of sand. Within 6" above the conduit the trench backfill shall contain no stones larger than 2". Metallic telecom warning tape shall be placed in the trench at a depth of 12" below finished grade. Trench depths may vary only with permission of the owner if existing conditions prohibit the minimum cover requirements.

Materials Purchase Responsibility

The Town of Charlemont will be responsible for purchasing and delivering to the site the following materials:

- 8-cell microduct
- 4-cell microduct
- 17"x30" junction boxes
- 14"x16" junction boxes
- Pedestals

The Contractor will be responsible for purchasing and installing the following materials:

- Washed stone for junction box bases (12" min. depth)
- Loam and seed for tree belt/lawn restoration
- Sand bedding
- Gravel for roadway trench restoration (12" minimum depth at both paved and unpaved crossings)
- Hot mix asphalt for roadway trench patches (4" minimum depth placed in two layers or as otherwise approved by the Highway Superintendent)
- 2" Galvanized Steel Conduit and pipe clips for riser poles
- 2" schedule 40 PVC pipe and bends
- 2" steel/PVC transition couplings
- Road warning signs for traffic control
- metallic telecom utility warning tape
- any other incidental materials to properly complete the work as shown on the plans and details

Town will provide tax forms so that materials may be purchased without Sales Tax on their behalf.

Accommodation of Traffic and Emergency Vehicles

Residences on these roads have only one access out and the Contractor is required to keep the road open to traffic and emergency vehicles at all times. Trench road crossings shall be done one-half the

road width at a time to allow one side of the road to remain open to alternating one-way traffic.

Police Details

It is anticipated that police details will be not be required for the work in the tree belt. If police are needed for road crossings the Contractor shall coordinate with the Charlemont Board of Selectmen to arrange any necessary police details. The Town will pay for all such agreed-upon police details.

Dig Safe

The Contractor is responsible for arranging for Dig Safe to mark existing utilities and to obtain all necessary permits and follow all safety precautions including abiding by the so-called Trench Law.

Work Schedule Notifications

The Contractor is required to make weekly notifications in advance of his work to the following:

- Shelburne Emergency Dispatch
- Charlemont Town Hall,
- Charlemont Highway Department

Completion

The work is to be completed by October 31, 2019 unless an extension of time has been granted by the Owner.

Approval of Work and Town Representative

Westfield Gas and Electric Company will be representing the Town and performing inspection services. All work must be approved by WG&E before payment will be made.

Labor rates are per MA Prevailing Wage. Tables are included in Exhibit B. Certified Payroll must be submitted to the Town Executive Secretary Kathy Reynolds at the Charlemont Town Office.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- A. The Town of Charlemont at its discretion may hold a pre-construction meeting prior to the start of construction.
- B. In case of failure of the Bidder, after due notification of the contract, to sign the contract, the procurement officer may, at her option, determine the Bidder has abandoned the contract, and thereupon the proposal and acceptance shall be null and void and shall be at liberty to make other contracts with other parties.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- A. Bid Prices: The bidder shall submit his bid upon forms furnished by the FRCOG on behalf of the Town.
- B. The bidder shall specify a LUMP SUM PRICE for all work. All words and figures shall be in ink. In case of a discrepancy between the prices written in words and those in figures, the written word shall govern. The prices shall, without exception, include all royalties, permits and costs involved in the work.
- C. Signatures: All proposals shall be signed correctly with ink in the proper places provided, as follows: If the proposal is made by an individual, his name and post office address shall be given. If the proposal is made by a firm, partnership or corporation, it shall be signed by a person having such legal authority from the firm, partnership, or corporation and the person so signing the proposal shall give his own name and title (if any) in addition to the name and address of the President, Treasurer, and Manager shall be given. If the proposal is made by a firm or partnership, the names and addresses of the individual members shall be given. If the proposal is made by a Corporation, the name of the State under which the laws of the Corporation are chartered and the names, titles, and business addresses of the President, Treasurer, and Manager shall be given-

PROPOSAL & CONTRACT GUARANTY REQUIRED

Labor and Materials Payment Bond: **IF THE BID IS \$25,000 OR MORE**, the awarded Contractor shall furnish surety bonds as security for the payment of all persons performing labor on the project under this Contract and furnishing materials in connection with this Contract. The surety shall be a duly authorized surety company satisfactory to the Owner, listed on the current United States Department of Treasury "Department of the Treasury's listing of approved Sureties (Department Circular 570)" as authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as a condition of acceptability the successful bidder.

If required, the amount shall be 50% of the bid price.

REGISTERED TO DO BUSINESS

A. All Contractors shall be registered to do business within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Registration can be obtained through the Corporation Division of the Office of the Secretary. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts (617) 727-9640.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

- A. M.G.L c.30, 39M requires that public works construction contracts be awarded to the "lowest responsible and eligible bidder", defined as: The bidder (1) whose bid is the lowest of those bidders possessing the skill, ability and integrity necessary for the faithful performance of the work.
- B. The low bid will be determined based on the lump sum bid.
- C. Method for Breaking Bid Tie:

Should there be two or more bids for this Contract that are identical and where the bidders are determined to all be responsible and eligible in accordance with MGL Chapter 149, the following procedure will be used to determine the winner.

- a. The Contract will be awarded to that bidder with its office in Franklin County
- b. If there is no bidder with its office located within Franklin County, the bid shall be awarded to a firm with its office in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- c. If there are two or more identically priced bidders with offices located within Franklin County or outside Franklin County, but in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the award of the Contract shall be determined by the toss of a coin. Such a toss shall be done with two witnesses. The respective bidders will be notified and invited to come to the FRCOG office to witness the coin toss.
- d. If there are more than two identical bids, the coin toss method shall be used by

- selecting the first two bidders in alphabetical order and eliminating one with a coin toss. This process shall be continued until such time as there remains only one bidder.
- D. Bidders are required to **disclose all Federal, State, or local agency citations** for the last three years.
- E. The Contractor will **not be permitted to either assign or underlet the contract**, nor assign either legally or equitably any monies hereunder, or its claim thereto without the previous written consent of the Town of Charlemont.
- F. If in the judgment of the Town of Charlemont any property is needlessly damaged by an act or omission of the Contractor or his employees, servants, or agents, the amount of such damages shall be determined by the Town of Charlemont designee and such amount shall be deducted from any money due the contractor or may be recovered from said contractor in actions at law.
- G. It should be further noted that all construction safety precautions and/or regulations required by the U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration shall be a condition of this project and shall be strictly enforced.

APPLICABLE LAWS

A. All applicable laws and regulations of the State of Massachusetts will apply to any resulting agreement, contract or Purchase Order.

TAXES

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT AND SMALL AND/OR MINORITY BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS

A. It is policy of Town of Charlemont that small and/or minority business enterprises shall have the maximum practicable opportunity to participate in the performance of public contracts. Bidder agrees that if this bid is accepted, he/she will not engage in employment practices which have the effect of discriminating against employees or prospective employees because of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, age, handicap, or political belief or affiliation. In addition, bidder agrees by submittal of

CONTRACT TERMINATION

A. The TOWN upon written notice of intent to cancel may cancel any contract. The Vendor/Contractor will be required to honor all Purchase Orders that were prepared and dated prior to the date of expiration or cancellation if received by the Vendor/Contractor within a period of thirty (30) days following date of expiration or cancellation. Cancellation by the TOWN does not relieve the Vendor/Contractor of any liability arising out of default or non-performance.

CHANGE ORDERS

A. A Change Order may be issued to adjust the price if field conditions differ substantially or materially from the plans and work description or if the TOWN suspends or delays the work for 15 days or more. (M.G.L. c. 30, §§ 39N-39O). A Sample Change order is found after the Sample Contract this RFQ package. At the time of contracting, the person who may approve change orders on behalf of the Town will be designated and the contractor should be aware that the Town is not obligated to pay for change orders that are not approved in writing. M.G.L. c. 44, § 31C; M.G.L. c. 30, § 39I). Change orders must be negotiated, due to the nature of the lump sum contract, and mutually approved by the Town and the Contractor.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENT

The Contractor shall at all times during the Contract maintain in full force and effect Commercial and Employer's Liability, Worker's Compensation, Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage, and General Liability Insurance including contractual liability coverage. All insurance shall be by insurers and for policy limits acceptable to the Town of Charlemont and before commencement of work hereunder the Contractor agrees to furnish the Town certificates of insurance or other evidence satisfactory to the Town of Charlemont to the effect that such insurance has been procured and is in force.

For the purpose of the Contract, the Contractor shall carry insurance per Article 7 of the attached Sample Contract.

The Town of Charlemont shall be named as an additional insured under the liability and automobile insurance. The excess/umbrella liability insurance policy should contain a broad form general liability endorsement.

EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF BIDS

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and save harmless the Town of Charlemont, and their respective duly elected or appointed officials, agents and employees (referred to collectively as "Town") from and against all demands, claims, damages, liabilities, losses, costs, and expenses (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney fees) (referred to collectively as "demands") arising out of or resulting from any work performed pursuant to this Agreement including but not limited to any negligent acts, errors, or omissions of the Contractor, any subcontractor of the Contractor, or any person directly or indirectly employed by any of them, or by a defect of a product or design supplied by the Contractor or subcontractor. Such obligation shall not negate, abridge, or reduce in any way any additional indemnification rights of the Town, that otherwise may exist under statute or in law or equity.
- b. Contractor assumes full responsibility for relations with any subcontractors employed directly or indirectly by the Contractor and the Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and save harmless the Town from all demands made against the Town by such subcontractor, such subcontractor's agent or employee, or any person, as the result of such subcontractor's work performed pursuant to this Agreement including but not limited to negligent acts, errors, or omissions that arise out of, result from, or are connected with the performance of this Agreement or any subsequent Agreement and is not otherwise subject to indemnifications under subparagraph "a" above.
- c. The Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Town from any and all demands relating to wages, overtime compensation, or other employee benefits by employees employed directly or indirectly by the Contractor for work performed in connection with the work hereunder or required by state or federal law, including but not limited to Fair Labor Standards Act and Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Law.

- d. The indemnification obligations of the Contractor and subcontractor shall not be limited in any way by any limitations on the amount or type of damages, compensations, or benefits payable by or for the Contractor or subcontractor under any federal or state law.
- e. In the event of a breach of this Agreement by the Contractor, the Contractor shall pay the Town all reasonable attorney fees, costs and other litigation expenses incurred by the Town in enforcing its rights as a result of said breach in addition to any damages for said breach.

6.00 LICENSES AND TAXES

The Contractor shall obtain all licenses and permits (other than the license and permit granted by the Contract) and promptly pay all taxes required by the Town of Charlemont.

7.00 INSURANCE

The Contractor shall at all times during the Contract maintain in full force and effect Employer's and Commercial Liability, Worker's Compensation, Bodily Injury Liability, Property Damage, and General Liability Insurance, including contractual liability coverage for the provisions of Section 5.00. All insurance shall be by insurers and for policy limits acceptable to the Town and before commencement of work hereunder the Contractor agrees to furnish the Town certificates of insurance or other evidence satisfactory to the Town to the effect that such insurance has been procured and is in force.

For the purpose of the Contract, the Contractor shall carry the following types of insurance in at least the limits specified below:

8.00 BASIS OF PAYMENT

The Town shall pay the Contractor for the Contractor's performance of the Contract the price of \$_____ which contract price includes completion of the entire project subject to additions and deductions by an amendment to the Contract Documents or an approved change order.

PREVAILING WAGES as determined by the Massachusetts Dept of Labor must be paid. Wage Schedule is attached.

The FRCOG has no liability for any costs incurred by the Town under this contract, and all scheduling, acceptance of products/services and invoicing shall be done directly between the Contractor and the Town.

9.00 TERM

Work to be completed by October 31, 2019 unless extended by permission of Board of Selectmen.

10.00 TRANSFERABILITY OF CONTRACT

No assignment of the Contract or any right accruing under this Contract shall be made in whole or in part by the Contractor without the express written consent of the TOWN, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld; in the event of any assignment, the assignee shall assume the liability and duties of the Contractor, but said assignment shall in no way relieve the Contractor of his liabilities or duties pursuant to the Contract.

11.00 MODIFICATIONS

No modification, waiver or change shall be made in the terms and conditions of this Contract, except as may be mutually agreed upon in writing by all parties hereto. Mutually acceptable changes may be processed through the Change Order procedure acceptable and as may be permitted by MGL c.30,39M.

12.00 TERMINATION

The Town may terminate this Contract by providing the Contractor with written notice if the Contractor violates any of the terms of this Contract.

In the event of suspension, the Town will set forth the specific grounds for the suspension, any actions the Contractor could take to correct the problems or situations, and a stated period of time for the Contractor to comply with the corrections required. Failure to correct the problems or situations that necessitated the suspension within the stated period of time shall be grounds for termination.

The Town shall have the right to terminate this Contract without cause upon five (5) days notice to the Contractor and all preceding paragraphs herein shall be applicable to this termination.

13.00 AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

This contract is contingent upon the availability of funds. This Contract shall be canceled by the Town if funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available to support continuation of performance.

14.00 NOTICES

Any and all notices or other communications required or permitted by this Contract or by law to be served or given to either the Town or the Contractor by the other party shall be in writing and shall be deemed duly served and given when personally delivered to the party to whom it is directed, or in lieu of such personal services when sent by U.S. mail, first-class, postage prepaid, addressed to the TOWN OF CHARLEMONT, 321 ZOAR ROAD, CHARLEMONT, MA 01367 or the Contractor AT

15.00 BOND

15.01 Performance Bond- not required for this contract

15.02 Payment Bond -50% (IF CONTRACT PRICE IS \$25,000 OR MORE)

The Contractor shall be obligated to provide the Town with a payment bond in the amount of 50% of the bid amount. The Bonds shall be submitted to the Town prior to Contract execution. Premium for the bonds shall be paid for by the Contractor.

16.00 CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Each party shall adhere to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 268A, with respect to the Conduct of Public Employees. In addition, no member, officer, or employee of either party, or its designees, or agents, no member of the governing body of the locality in which the program is situated, and no other public official of such locality or localities who exercises any functions or responsibilities with respect to the program during his tenure or for one (1) year thereafter (or such longer period as may be provided in Chapter 268A of the Massachusetts General Laws), shall have any interest in any contract or subcontract, or the proceeds thereof, for work to be performed in connection with the program assisted under this Agreement. Each party shall incorporate, or cause to be incorporated, in all such contracts or subcontracts a provision prohibiting such interest, pursuant to the purposes of this subsection.

17.00 RECORDS AND CHOICE OF LAW

The Contractor shall make and keep for at least six years after final payment, books, records, and accounts, which in reasonable detail accurately and fairly reflect the transactions and dispositions of the Contractor. (MGL c 30, §29R(b)(1)-(2).

This Contract shall be construed and governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Contractor, and the agents thereof, agree to bring any federal or state legal proceedings arising under this Contract to a court of competent jurisdiction in Franklin County, Massachusetts. This section shall not be construed to limit any rights a party may have to intervene in any action, in any court or wherever, pending, in which the other is a party.

18.00 MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT WARRANTY

Materials and equipment to be installed as part of the Work (both or either of which are hereinafter referred to as "materials") shall be as specified and approved by the Town DESIGNEE and used in accordance with the best construction practices.

The Town may reject unsuitable work, notwithstanding that such work and materials may have previously been accepted for payment. If any part of the Work shall be found defective at any time before the final acceptance of the whole Work, the Contractor shall promptly correct such defect in a manner satisfactory to the Town. If any material brought upon the site for use in the Work shall be deemed as not in conformity with the Contract Documents, the Contractor shall promptly remove such materials from the site.

19.00 RISK OF LOSS

The Contractor shall bear the risk of loss with respect to any of its or its agents' employees or subcontractors' vehicles, equipment or tools brought onto or left at the worksite and for any materials stored at the worksite.

20.00 ENTIRE UNDERSTANDING

This Contract, together with all documents included by reference pursuant to Clause 1.02 of this Contract, represents the entire understanding of the parties, and neither party is relying upon any representation not contained herein.



PROJECT DETAIL PLANS






TYPICAL FIBER INFRASTRUCTURE SPECIFICATION




RISER POLE DETAIL
